



FRIGATE NAVARRA

The frigate ESPS Navarra (F-85) is the fifth of the Santa Maria Class frigates, built by empresa nacional Bazán (NAVANTIA) in the Ferrol shipyards. She was commissioned to the Spanish Navy on May 30th 1994.

This type of frigate, known as FFG (guided missile frigate), has been designed in the United States as an escort for amphibious ships and aircraft-carriers, with her sophisticated combat system, along with her guns, missiles, torpedoes and SH60B LAMPS, gives the ship great surface, air and submarine warfare capability.

The frigate ESPS Navarra has participated in several Peacekeeping operations such as ATALANTA and SOPHIA and also in NATO Combined naval clusters, such as STANAVFORLANT, STANAVFORMED, SNMG-1 and SNMG-2.
